College Introduction

Dr. A. Q. Khan College of Science & Technology Bahria Town Phase 8, Islamabad was renamed as Dr. A. Q. Khan School & College Bahria Town Phase -8 in 2021. It is the flagship College in the chain of five academic institutions founded by Bahria Town Rawalpindi/Islamabad. Our campus started its functioning with effect from September 1, 2009 but was formally inaugurated by the eminent nuclear scientist of our country Late Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan (whose name adorns the campus). Captain (R) Muhammad Kazim (Pak Navy) was appointed as first Principal, who led the College till 18th October, 2020.

The present principal took over the responsibilities with effect from 19th October 2020. Our Campus consists of four main blocks, namely Malik Riaz Block, Ilyas Block, Ali Block and Rafi Block.

Pre-School is housed in Rafi Block. Play Group (8 x sections), Nursery (8 x sections) and Prep (8 x sections) classes are being run in this block. Three Activity Rooms, Day Care Center and staff room are located in the Rafi Block. Moreover, Art Room of primary wing is also located in the same building.

Primary Wing (classes I-V) of the College is located in Ali Block. There are 30 x sections, 6 x sections of each class. In the Primary Wing, there is a dedicated Library, Multimedia Room, Computer Lab and 2 x

staff rooms and Wing Head (Primary Wing) office are also located in the same building. There is a play land and main sports ground of the campus adjacent to the block.

Boys Wing (classes (VI-XII), of the College is located in Malik Riaz Block. There are 21 x sections, 3 x sections of each class (VI-XII). In the Boys Wing, there is a dedicated Multimedia Room / Language Lab. Computer Lab, and 3 x staff rooms, Principal, Headmistress and Wing - Head (Boys) offices are located in this building. Moreover, College Reception, Account Office, Admin Office, Academic Branch, Establishment Branch and Auditorium are also located in the same building.

Girls Wing (classes IV - XII) of the College is located in Ilyas Block. 3 x swimming pools, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computer Laboratories are located in the basement area of the Block. College Exam Hall/Multi Purpose Hall and Main Library are located on ground floor of the block. Girls' classes IV-VI are being conducted in the class rooms located on first floor of the building. VII-IX classes for girls are on the second floor while X-XII classes are on the third floor of the block.

Our Campus do have dedicated Tube-Well and Water Filter Plant for the fulfilment of drinking, cleaning and other needs of water. College has 22 x vehicles for the transportation of faculty members, employees and small portion of students. Campus do have Book Shops & Cafeterias separately for girls & boys to meet the needs of stationery and food requirements of the students.

College has dedicated, experienced and well qualified faculty to impart quality education to the students. College is contributing in character building and social grooming of students through various co-curricular (CCA) and extra-curricular activities (ECA). There are six clubs namely Literary & Debating Club, Computer & Science Club, Community Service Club, Drama & Entertainment Club, Photography & Fine Art Club and Sports & Adventure Club in the College. For the CCA/ECA there are six academic houses namely Jinnah House, Iqbal House, Sir Syed House, Fatima House, Raa'na House and Nisa House for heathy competitions among the students in various fields.

Our Campus also have play-land and large sports area containing Basket Ball, Football, Hockey, Volleyball and Badminton courts. Table tennis facilities for boys and girls are separately being provided. Team of male and female instructors is available for the provision of conducive sports facilities to the students.

College has dedicated website and face book page for the effective communication between school and parents/students. Moreover, campus do have internal security cameras for meaningful security and vigilance from any threat. Apart from that College horticulture department keeps the campus green and blossoming with seasonal flowers through out the year.

Reception

We have an immaculate reception area to welcome our wide variety of visitors and guide them to their specific destination. Fundamental information regarding our prestigious institute and its policies can be received from the college reception. Our Reception desk plays a vital role to maintain telephonic communication between parents and college administration. It also contributes to the security of the institution by helping to monitor visitors accessing the institution.











Admin & Accounts Office

The Admin and Account offices can be found on the ground floor of the Malik Riaz Block. Both departments are executing their respective duties efficiently ensuring the smooth functioning of the system.





Academic Branch

Academic Branch is available on the ground floor of Malik Riaz Block. This Branch is playing an effective role in the processes of new admissions, coordination with FBISE for Board classes and terminal examinations during the session.



Day Care

To ensure workplace support, Dr. A. Q. Khan School & College Bahria Town Phase-8 provides the facility of Day-Care to its faculty members. Availability of a very carefully planned Day-Care in the college premises enables the faculty members with infants and toddlers to stay focused towards their professional goals.













Cafeteria & Stationery Shop

Three clean and well maintained cafeterias separately for the students of Primary, Girls and Boys Wings under the strict supervision of the college management are available for the students. The College hygiene Committee keeps a strict check on these cafeterias to ensure provision of healthy food to the students.

Stationery shops seperately for boys and girls are also available in the college to facilitate the students and parents. College uniforms for students at all levels, books/ notebooks (from P.G-XII) and all types of regular stationery items can easily be accessed through these stationery shops.









Pre-School

Our Pre-school wing is nestled in the Rafi Block. It includes 25 airy and bright class rooms, three activity rooms and an art room. This section is well equipped to meet the needs of young children. A very carefully organized system helps them to explore and learn in a very comfortable environment. Our Pre-school offers a strong and effective curriculum based on the Montessori philosophy fostering self-esteem, independence, empathy and social consciousness. Our trained teachers in Pre-school empowered with the appropriate knowledge and professional competencies play a vital role not only in the physical, cognitive and emotional development of children but also enable them to acquire academic skills through interesting activities.







Play Group

Children within the age bracket of 3 to 4 years are allotted admission in Play Group. Play Group classrooms provide a friendly and caring environment to set an excellent foundation for the future academic life of the students. The administration ensures constant care and use of adequate Montessori equipment to capture the interest of young explorers. Curriculum of P.G is designed by strictly following the internationally recognized benchmarks and academic standards. The pace of studies is adopted according to the learning capacity of the children.









Nursery

Children of age 4 to 5 years are eligible to take admission in Nursery class. Our Nursery classrooms offer an environment of adventure and discovery to each child along with a challenging and exciting curriculum. This stage not only develops literacy skills but also inculcates a love for learning and a positive self-image. The proficiently designed curriculum will help young children to eliminate their queries through exploration, experimentation and conversation. Curriculum focuses on the development of reading, writing, listening and speaking skills as well as to make a child adept at sequence counting.











Prep

Prep classes are planned to prepare young students for the academic demands of formal school life. In this year, they not only enhance their communication skills but also strengthen their literacy and numeracy skills. Students are provided with a broad range of curricular and co-curricular opportunities to gain a clear knowledge and understanding of the world. The curriculum of Prep class encompasses English & Urdu languages (Listening, Speaking, Reading & Writing), Mathematics(Numeracy), Islamic Studies, history, music and creative art. By end of the year, children are able to comprehend written passages, construct sentences and have a fair knowledge of numbers.

Primary Wing

Primary wing (Classes I-V) is housed in Ali Block. There are 25 classrooms in this block which are spacious and fully furnished fulfilling the needs of the students. The students are provided with a well-stocked library to explore different books according to their interest. A well-furnished Computer Lab is also available in Ali Block to equip the students with the knowledge of computer technology. Well qualified and trained teaching staff provide students an opportunity to learn through fun activities. Projects and assignments enable them to develop additional skills integral to their future such as team-work, critical thinking and time management.






Girls Wing

This block includes 33 classrooms, four advanced science labs, three swimming pools and a spacious multipurpose hall. 





he college has sufficient arrangement to provide first aid to minor injuries and ailments. In case of any serious health issue, parents/guardians are informed immediately. MI Room provides an immediate, safe and supportive environment where students can receive basic medical care, assistance and support during school hours.











Transport Facility

he institution has an extensive fleet of well-maintained buses and vans which cover a large radius around Bahria Town Phase-8. All college vehicles are manned by expert and experienced drivers. The buses have a conductor to ensure the safety of all the students on board. The management ensures well behaved transport staff and comfortable vehicles for the satisfaction of the students as well as their parents.







Students' Counselling

School counsellors offer individual counselling to help students resolve personal or interpersonal problems. Student counsellors assist students at all levels from Pre-school to College. They listen to students concerns about academic, their emotional or social problems and guide them on their behavioural problems. The College provides these sessions through College Counsellors (FMs from Psychology department) as well as by professionally trained psychologist/counsellor from Bahria Rehab Center.





Rules & Regulations

A summary of rules for the students is appended below:

- The College keeps a strict policy regarding Discipline. A strict disciplinary action, including expulsion from the college, shall be taken against the DISCIPLINE CASES.
- MOBILES/CAMERAS are strictly prohibited and will be confiscated.
- The college encourages sports activities and provides sports gear to the students during games periods. The students are Not allowed to bring their own sports gear in the College.
- Vandalism, immoral conduct i.e stealing, use of abusive language, gross misbehaviour, show of disrespect/rudeness to the staff and the senior students shall be considered major offences and shall warrant strict disciplinary action.
- Disrespect to the teachers shall be considered an unpardonable offence. A severe and swift action (including expulsion from the college) shall be taken against such offences.
- The students are to follow the uniform code strictly. Those who are dressed in violation of the dress code on any day would not be allowed to attend the classes.
- Students are expected to be regular and punctual. Penalties shall be awarded to habitual late comers. The college gates will be closed daily at 0745 and no students will be allowed in thereafter.
- The name of a student who remains absent from the college for ten consecutive days without leave is liable to be struck off the college rolls.
- As per Board policy regarding attendance, a student who records an attendance less than 75% shall not be allowed to sit the final examination and will be required to repeat the class.
- Bullying is considered highly undesirable and is aggressively curbed and discouraged. We expect the students to develop courage to report the cases of bullying to the college authorities.
- All types of Intoxicating devices/ electronic cigarettes/ drugs/ Narcotics are strictly prohibited and the students carrying any such thing shall be expelled from the College.
- The girl students are Not allowed to wear makeup and jewellery. A simple ear ring is, however, allowed to protect and keep in tact the ear piercing. Only black or brown hair bands and ruffles are allowed; fancy items are not to be used. Girl students may also use white scarves only.
- The boy students are to have proper haircut. They are not allowed to wear long or fancy hair irrespective of the fashion in vogue.
- Students may use fountain pens but they are Not allowed to bring Ink-pots.
- Students are Not allowed to ride motorbikes or drive cars to college even if they hold a valid driving licence and even if they make arrangements to park their vehicles outside the college.
- Cheating in the examination is considered a major offence and is liable for strict punishment.





Admission Policy

Admission in Dr. A. Q. Khan College is based strictly on open merit for boys and girls upon no discrimination. There are no reserved seats. Admissions are announced on annual basis with selection criteria determined by a written test followed by a series of interviews. The college also admits students during the academic year dependent upon vacancy.

While we admit students in all year groups, the most preferable is kindergarten or year eleven. Our secondary education (SSC and HSSC) is affiliated with the Federal Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education (FBISE). Following English as medium of instruction, we follow the Cambridge/Oxford University-outlined curriculum for primary and middle schools while FBISE-mandated courses are followed at upper levels.

Assessment and Evaluation

Examination And Evaluation

A systematic process of students' assessment is pursued as an essential element of the College Calendar. Their academic standing is adjudged regularly and back up action devised promptly for improvement of performance. A classification of tests and examination is cited as under:

Fortnightly Evaluation

On completion of a unit/chapter/lesson, the students are required to take proper written test of each subject. Marks obtained are kept in the Record and also sent to the parents for information and signature.

Weekly Assessment

A spot test of short duration is held every week to ascertain the comprehension and study routine of the students. it may be conducted orally or in writing as per the requirement of the course contents. The attainment is recorded on the students' performance chart.

End-Term Examination

The end term examination is held twice a year at the close of 1st and Second terms of the academic session. The students' result and standing in the class/section are communicated to parents through a formal 'Result Report'. The marked answer scripts too are returned along.




