Revisions always make the concepts stronger and memorable. These themes can be revised through videos available online to develop their interest in the world around us.

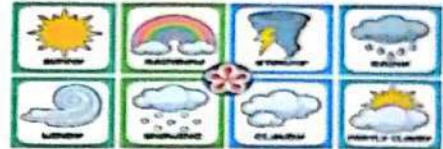
Some bullets before starting your screen time:

- ❖ You have played outside for 20 minutes.



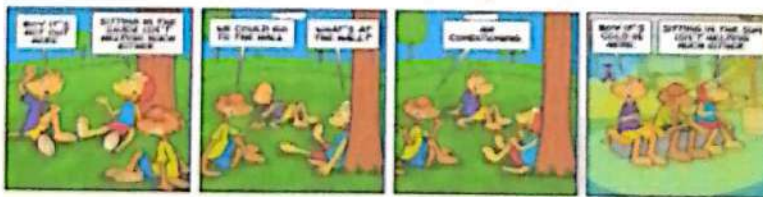
Fun things to do in summer:

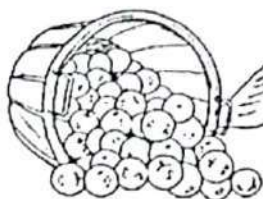

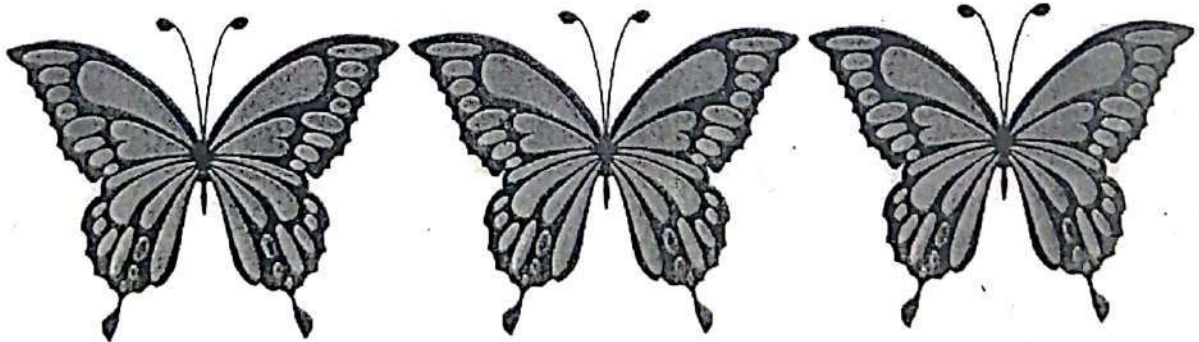
