Subj: New Academic Session - 2022/2023

#### Dear Parents

- 1. The new academic session of Pre School has already been started from 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2022, whereas for classes 1 to 9<sup>th</sup> (new) are commencing from 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022. College has taken certain steps in the light of Education Policy by the Government. Brief summary is given below:
  - a. Single National Curriculum (SNC) was implemented for classes 1 to 5 last year.
  - b. Single National Curriculum (SNC) is being implemented for classes 6 to 8 from current academic session.
  - c. Federal Board (FBISE), Islamabad is implementing Students Learning Outcomes (SLOs) based assessment system for SSC & HSSC students from May & June 2022 for which College is preparing our students accordingly.
  - d. Chairman FBISE was invited in the College on 16<sup>th</sup> Dec 2021 and he clearly explained the students about SLOs based assessment system.
  - e. From current academic session, assessment of students from grade 6 to 8 (internal exam) will also be conducted on SLOs based, so students could easily be prepared for SSC & HSSC examinations being conducted by FBISE.
  - f. SLO based assessment system ensures understanding and concepts of students instead of focusing on memorization or rote learning.
- From 28<sup>th</sup> March 2022 (new academic session) College is separating boys and girls from classes 1
  Brief summary is given below:
  - a. <u>Pre-School</u>. The classes of students for play group, nursery and prep are being conducted in Rafi Block of the College. The boys and girls will study together (as per existing routine).
  - b. <u>Primary Wing.</u> Classes of boys and girls are separated from class 1 onward. However, classes 1 to 3 for girls are located on ground floor of Ali Block, whereas, boys from 1 to 5 are accommodated on first and second floors of same block.
  - c. <u>Girls Wing</u>. For girls of classes from 4 to 12, a separate wing has been established in Ilyas Block of the College.



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- d. Boys Wing. For boys of classes from 6 to 12, a separate wing has been established in Malik Riaz Block of the College.
- 4. Books, Uniform and Stationery Items. Parents are given liberty to purchase uniform/books/stationery items as per list/format from anywhere without having Logo/name of College. Moreover, for computer education, for classes 1 to 5, College have composed three in one work-books (text, note and practical) that too at very economical rate are provided to the students.
- 5. Financial Aspects. By separating boys and girls in different wings, College has to take up certain administrative & management level actions for which brief summary is given blow:
  - a. Extra class – rooms with allied facilities.
  - b. Employment of new teachers and Para-education staff.
  - Establishment of Science, multi-media and computer laboratories. Ç.
  - Staff rooms. d.
  - Detailing of new wing heads, class coordinators and sports staff. e.
- 6. College Sources of Income. The main sources of income to meet all the expanses are:
  - Admission Fee (for newly admitted students only). a.
  - Monthly Tuition Fee. b.
  - Annual Charges. C.
  - Transport Charges (to whom College is providing pick/drop services) đ.
- Request to Parents. Parents are requested to pay the tuition fee on regular basis to avoid 7. inconvenience by following new time line starting from April 2022:
